Year-end is fast approaching. It has been a very challenging year and we want to express our sincere appreciation for your hard work and dedication to deliver quality products. Despite those efforts, Visteon's global supply base PPM performance has declined compared with 2009 performance and is short of our 25 PPM goal.

Many of you may take advantage of extended shutdown periods to perform maintenance and overall plant improvements in December. Experience has proven that an ad hoc approach to production line startup following an extended shut-down can negatively impact product quality.

As 2010 comes to an end, we are requesting you take steps to mitigate the risk of potential disruptions by establishing and implementing a disciplined post-shutdown startup plan. To assist you, Visteon has a simple checklist that captures key items to consider. Startup plans should be completed by Dec. 17 to prepare for the extended shutdown period. After this date, Visteon Supplier Performance engineers will conduct random audits and contact select suppliers to review their plans. Failure to implement a plan may result in Significant Quality Event (SQE) demerit points in your supplier report card.

For the remainder of 2010 and in particular for 2011, please be reminded of Visteon's non-negotiables and specific requirements. As a business partner, it is critical you adhere to these procedures and requirements.
